The audit is done by means of a user friendly audit process, covering compliance to the following checklist:

- 6. Documentation to ensure traceability

- 10. Avoidance of contamination
- 11. Procedures to prevent contamination via undesired substances
- 12. Procedures to avoid risks of external contamination
- 13. Cleaning of trucks

- 17. Corrective actions in case of spillage and accidents
- 18. Recognition of the importance of food safety management and relevant procedures
